

For Youth: Your Rights and Responsibilities in School

All children and youth in the United States have the right to receive a free public education, regardless of their immigration status, language, or academic level.



Children and Youth's Rights:



Receive support in school as an English learner



Have access to appropriate materials for your grade level in all subjects



Be placed in a classroom environment with other students your age



Participate in programs the school offers, such as those for advanced students or students with disabilities, clubs, and sports



Have a safe, orderly, and drug-free learning environment free from bullying, harassment, and any form of discrimination

Children and Youth's Responsibilities:	
	Attend school regularly
	Arrive at school on time
	Be ready to learn every day
	Follow the school dress code
	Help maintain a safe and orderly school environment
	Do not fight with other students, bring weapons or drugs to school, participate in gangs, use offensive language, or threaten others
	Show respect and consideration for the property and rights of others
