## ELIGIBILITY

A person under 18 who is not a U.S. citizen or a Green Card Holder and has been forced to work or was paid for sex can get help from Aspire. If you're 18 or older, USCRI's TVAP program may be able to help.

## SERVICES

Aspire helps kids and teens get important services, like immigration lawyers, doctors, and help with food and clothes. Each child is assigned a case manager who works with you and your family. Aspire services are free and private.
